Answer 1

Option D is correct, this is a type of heterotrophic nutrition. This is a parasitic relationship as the plant causes a disadvantage to the other organism (the fungus).

This is not an example of saprophytic nutrition as it doesn't involve the release of enzymes or extracellular digestion. Even though it is a plant species, *E. aphyllum* is not an autotroph because it has no chlorophyll and therefore cannot photosynthesise.
