### Answer 1

The correct answer is D as it is not easy to mimic natural environments, especially as natural environments are not static and are in fact incredibly complex.

Option A is incorrect as the mesocosm does allow control of environmental conditions, such as light intensity or temperature.

Option B is incorrect as a mesocosm does allow many repeat readings to be taken which provides reliable data.

Option C is incorrect as continuous data can be collected e.g. rate of growth.
